TERRACYCLE Terra Cycle

Terracycle collects and recycles hard-to-recycle items that are not accepted in conventional waste streams, and then 'upcycles' them to produce a range of new consumer products. The company collects and recycles consumer items such as beauty products, toothpaste tubes and coffee capsules and industrial waste including that generated within distribution and production centres.
